To put North Island's experience in it proper context, we also visited the NADEPs at Cherry Point, NC, at Jacksonville, FLA, and at Norfolk, VA, as well as the Naval Air Systems Command in Washington, D.C., and the Aviation Supply Office in Philadelphia, PA.
